

FREQUENT ASKED QUESTIONS

What exams do I need to take to be eligible to teach in the Compton Unified School District?

- You need to take and pass the California Basic Educational Skills Test (CBEST) (<http://www.cbest.nesinc.com/>).
- You need to satisfy the subject matter requirement in your desired subject area. One option is to take and pass the California Subject Exam for Teachers (CSET) in your desired subject area (this is the only option for elementary teachers). (<http://www.cset.nesinc.com/>)
- Secondary teachers may also complete an approved university subject matter program.

Where can I go to apply for a teaching position?

You can apply for any certificated teaching position online at www.Edjoin.org or through the homepage of the District website (click 'Apply' in the upper right hand side) www.compton.k12.ca.us.

How much will I be paid?

You will be paid according to the appropriate salary schedules (for more info, see Salary and Benefits. The salary range in the district for credentialed teachers is \$45,317 - \$84,493.

What happens after I submit my application?

Your application will be pre-screened to ensure that you are eligible to teach in the Compton Unified School District. If you are eligible you will receive an email to outline a series of next steps (interviewing, hiring, etc.). If you are not eligible you will receive an e-mail informing you that you were ineligible to teach in the Compton Unified School District.
