The following evaluation questions should assist you in developing a comprehensive narrative that incorporates information that is collected in the form of performance data, surveys, attendance, input, and other data from students, parents, staff and administrators. The data in conjunction with your strategy/action analysis will allow you to prepare comprehensive answers for the questions. The results of the evaluation are shared with all stakeholders including parents, teachers, students, community members, governance committees, councils, district stakeholders and Board Members. The evaluation should serve as the tool that guides the revision of the current Single Plan for Student Achievement.

3. What has not worked well in the Title I program?
4. What needs to be changed?
5. How should the Title I program be refined?
