

# Financial Aid BINGO

## Materials Needed:

- Financial Aid BINGO card for each student
- Financial Aid BINGO Vocabulary sheets
- A set of Facilitator Cards
- BINGO marking tool (i.e. marker, highlighter, pen, pencil)

**Time Allowed:** 20-30 minutes

## Directions:

1. Distribute BINGO cards, Financial Aid BINGO Vocabulary Words sheets, and supply marking tools, if needed, to each student.
2. Pull a facilitator's card from the stack; read aloud the definition (not the vocabulary word.) Students mark the corresponding vocabulary word on their BINGO card.
3. Continue reading definitions from the facilitator cards until a student calls "BINGO!" (Five squares in a row, across, down or diagonally).
4. Ask the winner to read their words aloud so you can verify that they were defined. It's possible that as they are still learning, they may get definitions confused.
5. Following each BINGO round, take a moment to ask for questions. It is not unusual for students to miss one or more of the words or misunderstand a definition.

# Financial Aid BINGO Vocabulary

1. **AB540**- signed into law by Governor Gray Davis on October 12, 2001, allowing access to in-state tuition rates for undocumented and other eligible students at California's public colleges and universities.
2. **Budget**- a financial plan based on how much money an individual or family makes, how much they spend, and how much they save.
3. **CA Dream Act**- the name given to Assembly Bills 130 & 131, which allow some undocumented students to apply for and receive state-based financial aid and institutional scholarships
4. **Cal Grant**- a financial aid program administrated by the California Student Aid Commission (CSAC) providing aid to California undergraduates, vocational training students, and those in teacher certification programs. Cal Grants are the largest source of California state funded student financial aid
5. **Chafee Grant**- free money for current or former California foster youth to help pay for college or career and technical training. Chafee Grants don't have to be paid back. You may also use your grant to pay for child care, rent and transportation while you're in school.
6. **Checking Account**- a bank account that allows account holders to write checks or use a debit card to make purchases
7. **Cost of Attendance**-the price of a college that includes tuition, fees, room and board, transportation and other expenses.
8. **EFC (Expected Family Contribution)** – the amount of money a student and his or her family are expected to contribute towards the cost of the student's education.
9. **Financial Aid Award Letter**- a letter received, via mail or email, from the college(s) to which the student applied, typically in early to mid-April. This letter will spell out the details of the financial aid package.
10. **Financial Aid**- financial assistance for students interested in pursuing postsecondary education.
11. **Financial Planning**- the process of setting goals for one's money and creating a plan of action for achieving those goals.
12. **Interest**-a charge for a loan, usually a percentage of the amount loaned. For savings accounts, the amount of interest earned is an annual percentage of how much money is in the account; for credit cards, the amount of interest charged is an annual percentage on the balance owed to the credit card company.
13. **March 2<sup>nd</sup>**- the FAFSA and CA Dream Act deadline.
14. **Merit-Based Aid**- financial aid awarded to students based on their achievements, from high GPA's and test scores to accomplishments in athletics, extracurricular, or the arts.
15. **Middle Class Scholarship**- (MCS) provides undergraduate students, including students pursuing a teaching credential, with family incomes and assets up to \$171,000 a scholarship to attend University of California (UC) or California State University (CSU) campuses.
16. **Need-Based Aid**- financial aid awarded to students who would not be able to pay for postsecondary education using only their family's financial resources. Need is assessed using a formula designed to determine the difference between the cost of attending school and the amount a family is expected to contribute (EFC) toward the student's education.

# Financial Aid BINGO Vocabulary

17. **October 1<sup>st</sup>**- the first date that the FAFSA and CA Dream Act open.
18. **Pell Grant**– a federal, need-based grant that ranges from approximately \$400 to \$4,050 per year
19. **PLUS Loan**– the Parent Loan for Undergraduate Students is a federal loan that may be taken out by parents, and can cover the entire cost of college attendance less any other financial aid a student receives. These loans are unsubsidized, so interest begins to accrue immediately.
20. **Room and Board**– If you choose to live away from your home while you attend college this is the cost of a place to live and your meals and is the next most expensive cost of a college.
21. **Stafford Loan**– federal education loans available to students; may be subsidized or unsubsidized. They are the most common education loan taken by students.
22. **Student Aid Report (SAR)** – a document that lists all of the information a student provides on the FAFSA, as well as his or her Expected Family Contribution (EFC).
23. **Subsidized Loan**- a need-based loan for which the interest normally charged while the borrower is in school is paid by the government until the borrower leaves school and begins repayment.
24. **Unsubsidized Loan**– a loan for students who do not qualify for need-based aid or for students who are in need of assistance beyond the maximum subsidized loan offered to them. Unsubsidized loans begin accruing interest the moment they are accepted.
25. **Work-Study**– a need based federal program that is administered on a campus. Eligible students are provided jobs on campus or at a local organization.
