Reopening of Schools Service Delivery Models

RSP

Option 1: Hybrid Model

- Students are organized in two groups (A and B)
- Students receive in-person classroom instruction two days per week.



Reopening of Schools Service Delivery Models

RSP

Option 1: Hybrid Model

- Students in Group A attend in-person classroom instruction on Tuesdays and Wednesdays.
- Student in Group B attend in-person classroom instruction on Thursdays and Fridays.
- Mondays, only students with significant needs will participate in in-person instruction.

Option 2: Distance Learning

- Students will continue with Distance Learning from home for the remainder of the school year.



Reopening of School Service Delivery Models

SDC Mild/Moderate and Moderate/Severe

Option 1: Every Day In-person Instruction

- SDC M/M and M/S students (TK-6th) will attend Monday through Friday

Option 2:

- Students will continue with Distance Learning from home for the remainder of the school year.

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What is a Cohort?

- A **cohort** is a stable group of 14 children/youth or more if 6 feet can be maintained, and two supervising adults in a supervised environment in which supervising adults and children stay together for all activities as long as 6 feet of distance is maintained while wearing a mask at all times.
